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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

DECEMBER 1, 1947

Held by packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 110,030,109 lb. Of this total there were 93,985,109 lb. of reported stocks and 16,045,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 82,367,122 lb. and last month 61,876,139 pound. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "into-storage" movement of 48.2 million pound. A year ago there was a similar movement of 15.4 million lb.

PORK The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 45,842,673 lb. being 6,670,660 pound Fresh 16,397,214 lb. Frozen and 22,774,799 lb. Cured. With an addition of 9,195,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought up to 55,037,673 lb. which was an increase of 17.0 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 7.0 million lb. There were 47,192 lb. imported pork stocks.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 34,314,142 lb. being classified as follows: 11,644,328 lb. Fresh, 18,988,418 lb. Frozen 474,847 lb. Cured and 3,206,549 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 5,175,000 lb. the Grand Total was 39,489,142 lb. These stocks were 3.5 million lb. more than last year. The "into-storage" movement was 23.6 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 7.0 million lb.

VEAL The total holdings, including an estimate of 665,000 lb. were 7,679,591 pounds, being Fresh 1,204,203 lb. Frozen 5,314,279 lb. and Fancy Meats 496,109 lb. These stocks were 2.5 million lb. more than last month and 2.7 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings, were 6,813,703 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 1,140,872 lb. Frozen 5,471,981 lb. and Fancy Meats 200,850 lb. Including an estimate of 1,019,000 lb. the Grand Total was 7,823,703 lb. These figures show an increase of 5.2 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.1 million lb.

LARD The total stocks, including an estimate of 120,000 lb. were 2,185,567 lb. These stocks were 744 thousand lb. more than last month and 996 thousand lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on December 1 were 2,380,485 lb. which was an increase of 501 thousand lb. over last month.
