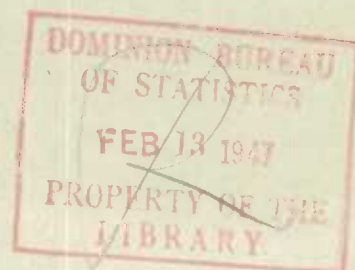

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD FEBRUARY 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 73,985,812 lb. Of this total there were 69,265,812 lb. of reported stocks and 4,720,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 77,469,671 lb. and last month 79,647,865 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 5.7 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 9.6 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 40,687,251 lb. being 3,903,601 lb. Fresh, 22,898,893 lb. Frozen and 13,884,757 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,445,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 43,132,251 lb. which was an increase of 4.5 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 4.2 million lb.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 21,402,976 lb. being classified as follows: 6,467,296 lb. Fresh, 11,417,575 lb. Frozen, 1,153,175 lb. Cured and 2,364,930 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,715,000 lb., the Grand Total was 23,117,976 lb. These stocks were 8.0 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 7.4 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 10 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 140,000 lb., were 2,143,395 lb., being Fresh 251,049 lb., Frozen 1,494,920 lb., and Fancy Meats 257,426 lb. These stocks were 1.3 million lb. less than last month and 1.2 million lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 420,000 lb., were 5,592,190 lb., consisting of Fresh 236,321 lb., Frozen 4,766,338 lb. and Fancy Meats 169,531 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 2.0 million lb.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on February 1, were 1,511,416 lb., which was a decrease of 43 thousand lb. from last month and an increase of 232 thousand lb. over last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 1,372,146 lb. These stocks were 83 thousand lb. less than last month and 446 thousand lb. more than last year.

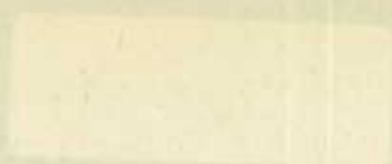
