

#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD MARCH 1, 1947

Held by Packers; Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 67,433,429 lb. Of this total there were 63,983,429 lb. of reported stocks and 3,450,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 71,571,862 lb. and last month 74,764,548 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 7.3 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 5.9 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 42,039,602 lb.
being 3,272,057 lb. Fresh, 21,600,873 lb. Frozen and 17,166,672 lb. Cured. With an
addition of 2,140,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late
or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 44,179,602 lb. which was an increase of
390 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 4.3
million lb.

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 17,220,023 lb. being classified as follows: 4,299,249 lb. Fresh, 9,075,394 lb. Frozen, 1,241,982 lb. Cured and 2,603,398 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,055,000 lb., the Grand Total was 18,275,023 lb. These stocks were 6.0 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 4.9 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 6.8 million lb.

VEAL The total holdings, including an estimate of 110,000 lb., were 1,218,602 lb., being Fresh 182,982 lb., Frozen 867,280 lb. and Fancy Meats 58,340 lb. These stocks were 989 thousand less than last month and 636 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

#### MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 145,000 lb., were 3,760,202 lb., consisting of Fresh 237,111 lb., Frozen 3,253,592 lb. and Fancy Meats 124,499 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.8 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.9 million lb.

#### KDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on March 1, were 1,263,573 lb., which was a decrease of 220 thousand lb. from last month and of 39 thousand lb. from last year.

LARD

The total stocks were 1,164,967 lb. These stocks were 254 thousand lb. less than last month and 352 thousand lb. less than last year.
