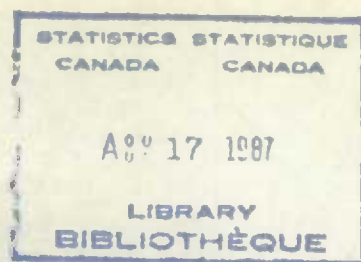

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD APRIL 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 62,987,413 lb. Of this total there were 61,052,413 lb. of reported stocks and 1,935,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 77,620,163 lb. and last month 67,559,293 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Out-of-Storage" movement of 4.6 million lb. A year ago there was an opposite movement of 6.0 million lb.

PORK The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 42,484,354 lb. being 3,820,869 lb. Fresh, 22,719,441 lb. Frozen and 15,944,044 lb. Cured. With an addition of 1,025,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 43,509,354 lb. which was a decrease of 887 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 9.2 million lb. There were 454,811 lb. of Imported Pork.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 14,783,750 lb. being classified as follows: 4,459,704 lb. Fresh, 7,531,142 lb. Frozen, 1,276,022 lb. Cured and 1,516,882 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 770,000 lb. the Grand Total was 15,553,750 lb. These stocks were 5.9 million lb. less than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement was 2.6 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 2.9 million lb. Stocks of Imported Beef amounted to 276,328 lb.

VEAL The total holdings, including an estimate of 90,000 lb. were 1,114,818 lb. being Fresh 476,702 lb., Frozen 468,685 lb. and Fancy Meats 79,431 lb. These stocks were 66 thousand lb. less than last month and 971 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB The total holdings, including an estimate of 50,000 lb. were 2,809,491 lb. consisting of Fresh 136,960 lb., Frozen 2,495,481 lb. and Fancy Meats 127,050 lb. These figures show a decrease of 971 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 523 thousand lb.

LARD The total stocks were 1,246,866 lb. These stocks were 33 thousand lb. more than last month and 185 thousand lb. less than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks on April 1, were 1,174,437 lb. which was a decrease of 110 thousand lb. from last month.

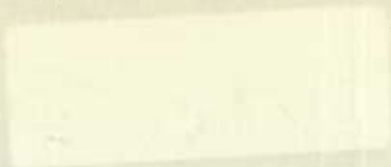
