COLD STURAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LAND MAY 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 77,280,190 lb. Of this total there were 66,505,190 lb. of reported stocks and 10,775,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 78,214,541 lb. and last month 63,644,125 1b. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 13.6 million 1b. A year ago there was a similar movement of 595 thousand 1b.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 48,216,504 lb. being 5,563,361 lb. Fresh, 25,448,794 lb. Frozen and 17,204,349 lb. Cured. With an addition of 7,700,000 lb. es an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 55,916,504 lb. which was an increase of 12 million lb. over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 7.7 million lb. There were 610,229 lb. if Imported Pork.

The reported holdings of Canadian Beef were 13,274,191 1b. being classified as follows: 4,493,052 lb. Fresh, 6,244,802 lb. Frozen, 1,288,341 lb. Cured and 1,247,996 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 2,920,000 lb. the Grand Total was 16,194,191 lb. These stocks were 1.8 million 1b. more than last year. The "Into-Storage" movement was 422 thousand 1b. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 7.1 million 1b. Stocks of Imported Beef amounted to 325,881 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 45,000 lb. were 3,059,380 lb. being Fresh 988,494 lb. Frozen 1,908,294 lb. and Fancy Meats 117,592 lb. These stocks were 1.9 million lb. more than last month and 329 thousand lb. less than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 110,000 lb. were 2,110,115 lb. consisting of Fresh 85,914 lb. Frozen 1,832,171 lb. and Fancy Meats 82,030 lb. These figures show a decrease of 738 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.3 million 1b.

LARD

The total stocks were 1,453,313 lb. These stocks were 164 thousand 1b. more than last month and 18 thousand 1b. more than last year.

Stocks on May 1 were 1,180,534 lb. which was a decrease of 16 thousand 1b. from last month.


