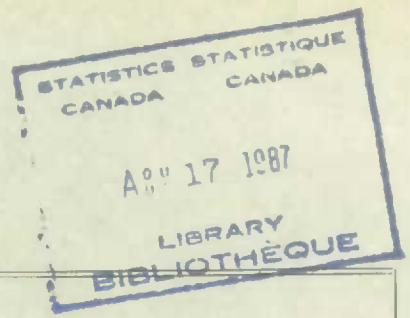

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

JUNE 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 77,406,929 lb. Of this total there were 71,081,929 lb. of reported stocks and 6,325,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 74,454,064 lb. and last month 77,343,795 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "Into-Storage" movement of 63 thousand lb. A year ago there was an opposite movement of 3.8 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 51,630,660 lb. being 4,851,258 lb. Fresh, 30,612,016 lb. Frozen and 16,167,386 lb. Cured. With an addition of 4,740,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 56,370,660 lb. which was an increase of 611 thousand lb. over last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 600 thousand lb. There were 297,620 lb. of Imported Pork.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian Beef were 13,044,939 lb. being classified as follows: 3,457,069 lb. Fresh, 6,731,926 lb. Frozen, 1,310,430 lb. Cured and 1,545,514 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,480,000 lb. the Grand Total was 14,524,939 lb. These stocks were 2.4 million lb. more than last year. The "Out-of-Storage" movement of 1.7 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 2.2 million lb. Stocks of Imported Beef amounted to 259,679 lb.

VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 75,000 lb. were 4,809,503 lb. being Fresh 755,062 lb. Frozen 3,830,045 lb. and Fancy Meats 149,396 lb. These stocks were 1.7 million lb. more than last month and 1.3 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON AND LAMB

The total holdings, including an estimate of 30,000 lb. were 1,701,827 lb. consisting of Fresh 51,661 lb. Frozen 1,528,926 lb. and Fancy Meats 91,240 lb. These figures show a decrease of 476 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.0 million lb.

LARD

The total stocks were 1,819,603 lb. These stocks were 285 thousand lb. more than last month and 524 thousand lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks on June 1 were 1,306,466 lb. which was an increase of 102 thousand lb. over last month.
