

#### COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

JULY 1, 1947

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Gold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 74,930,265 lb. Of this total there were 70,915,265 lb. of reported stocks and 4,015,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 72,052,820 lb. and last month 76,326,952 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 1.4 million lb. A year ago there was a similar movement of 2.4 million lb.

#### PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 52,280,563 lb. being 4,717,631 lb. Fresh, 31,428,328 lb. Frozen and 16,134,604 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,900,000 lb. as an estimate for firms whose schedules were received late or not at all, the Grand Total was brought to 55,180,563 lb. which was a decrease of 328 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 5.9 million lb. There were 301,634 lb. imported pork stocks.

#### BERF

The reported holdings of Canadian Beef were 12,102,371 lb. being classified as follows: 3,864,416 lb. Fresh, 5,258,089 lb. Frozen 1,185,639 lb. Cured and 1,794,227 lb. Fancy Meets. Including an estimate of 870,000 lb. the Grand Total was 12,972,371 lb. These stocks were 2.8 million lb. less than last year. The "out-of-storage" movement was 1.2 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 3.6 million lb. Stocks of Imported Beef amounted to 185,744 lb.

#### VEAL

The total holdings, including an estimate of 245,000 lb. were 5,393,826 lb. being Fresh 650,281 lb. Frozen 4,333,419 lb. and Fancy Meats 165,126 lb. These stocks were 488 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.9 million lb. more than last year's holdings.

#### MUTTON AND LAMB

The reported holdings, were 1,383,505 lb. consisting of Fresh 133,519 lb. Frozen 1,197,877 lb. and Fancy Meats 52,109 lb. These figures show a decrease of 326 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 204 thousand lb.

#### LARD

The total stocks were 2,526,819 lb. These stocks were 584 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.5 million lb. more than last year.

#### EDIBLE TAILOW

Stocks on July 1, were 1,332,688 1b. which was an increase of 24 thousand 1b. over last month.
