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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

MAY 1, 1948

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 119,817,492 lb. Of this total there were 114,857,492 lb. of reported stocks and 4,960,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 78,277,140 lb. and last month 131,893,285 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 12.1 million pounds. A year ago there was an opposite movement of 14.1 million lb.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 79,991,675 lb. being 4,376,996 lb. Fresh 56,057,906 lb. Frozen and 19,556,773 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,890,000 lb. as an estimate for firms that did not report on time or not at all, the Grand Total was brought up to 82,881,675 lb. which was a decrease of 4.1 million lb. from last month. Last year there was an opposite movement of 12.5 million pounds.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 26,608,069 lb. being classified as follows: 8,247,243 lb. Fresh 14,055,323 lb. Frozen 987,525 lb. Cured and 3,317,978 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,550,000 lb. the Grand Total was 28,158,069 lb. These stocks were 11.8 million lb. more than last year. The "out-of-storage" movement was 7.7 million lb. Last year's figures showed an opposite movement of 328 thousand lb.

VEAL

The total holdings were 4,106,476 lb. including an estimate of 130,000 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 932,573 lb. Frozen 2,295,450 lb. and Fancy Meats 158,453 lb. These stocks were 1.2 million lb. more than last month and 949 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON & LAMB

The reported holdings, were 4,281,272 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 212,673 lb. Frozen 3,807,825 lb. and Fancy Meats 260,774 lb. including an estimate of 390,000 lb., the Grand Total was 4,671,272 lb. These figures show a decrease of 1.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 660 thousand lb.

LARD

The total stocks amounted to 3,341,110 lb. These stocks were 442 thousand lb. less than last month and 1.8 million lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW.

Stocks on May 1 were 2,673,377 lb. an increase of 21 thousand pounds over last month and 1.4 million lb. over last year's holdings.
