

Last year the total was 78,807,853 lb. and last month 120,385,892 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 3.9 million pounds. A year ago there was an opposite movement of 531 thousand lb. "

COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD

JUNE 1, 1948

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT

The Canadian meat stocks totalled 97,039,915 1b. Of this total there were 92,054,915 1b. of reported stocks and 4,085,000 1b. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 78,807,853 1b. and last month 120,385,892 1b. The Canadian meat stocks showed an out-of-storage movement of 23.3 million pounds. A year and there was an opposite movement of 531 thousand 1b.

PORK

The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 80,220,716 lb., being 4,865,833 lb. Fresh 55,757,954 lb. Frozen and 19,596,929 lb. Cured. With an addition of 3,465,000 lb. as an estimate for firms that did not report on time or not at all, the Grand Total was brought up to 83,685,716 lb. which was an increase of 464 thousand pounds over last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 757 thousand pounds.

BEEF

The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 22,758,504 lb. being classified as follows: 7,236,107 lb. Fresh, 11,223,653 lb. Frozen, 969,930 lb. Cured and 3,328,814 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,415,000 lb. the Grand Total was 24,173,504 lb. These stocks were 9.3 million lb. more than last year. The "out-of-storage" movement was 4.3 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.5 million lb.

VEAL

The total holdings were 5,561,183 lb. including an estimate of 30,000 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 1,262,267 lb. Frozen 4,054,932 lb. and Fancy Meats 213,984 lb. These stocks were 1.4 million lb. more than last month and 630 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON & LAMB

The reported holdings were 2,974,202 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 141,292 lb. Frozen 2,704,064 lb. and Fancy Meats 128,846 lb. Including an estimate of 75,000 lb. the Grand Total was 3,049,202 lb. These figures show a decreese of 1.5 million lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 466 thousand lb.

LARD

The total stocks amounted to 3,763,396 lb. These stocks were 309 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.7 million lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on June 1 were 2,403,508 lb., a decrease of 283 thousand pounds from last month and an increase of 1.1 million lb. over last year's holdings.
