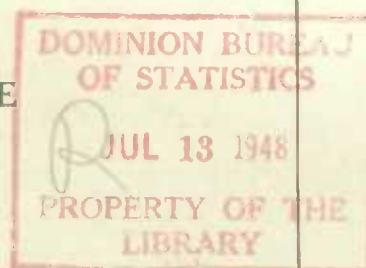

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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS OF MEAT AND LARD - JULY 1, 1948

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

ALL MEAT The Canadian meat stocks totalled 103,202,981 lb. Of this total there were 99,792,981 lb. of reported stocks and 3,410,000 lb. of estimates for late firms. Last year the total was 75,640,027 lb. and last month 115,789,944 lb. The Canadian meat stocks showed an "out-of-storage" movement of 12.6 million pounds. A year ago there was a similar movement of 3.2 million lb.

PORK The total reported stocks of Canadian pork were 71,809,962 lb. being 4,374,441 lb. Fresh 48,892,862 lb. Frozen and 18,542,659 lb. Cured. With an addition of 2,250,000 lb. as an estimate for firms that did not report on time or not at all, the Grand Total was brought up to 74,059,962 lb. which was a decrease of 9.3 million pounds from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 1.7 million pounds.

BEEF The reported holdings of Canadian beef were 20,230,536 lb. being classified as follows: 8,108,892 lb. Fresh 8,312,394 lb. Frozen 904,758 lb. Cured and 2,904,492 lb. Fancy Meats. Including an estimate of 1,030,000 lb. the Grand Total was 21,260,536 lb. These stocks were 8.2 million lb. more than last year. The "out-of-storage" movement was 2.5 million lb. Last year's figures showed a similar movement of 1.7 million lb.

VEAL The total holdings were 5,802,749 lb. including an estimate of 105,000 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 1,197,945 lb. Frozen 4,280,633 lb. and Fancy Meats 219,171 lb. These stocks were 172 thousand lb. more than last month and 317 thousand lb. more than last year's holdings.

MUTTON & LAMB The reported holdings were 2,054,734 lb. being classified as follows: Fresh 197,804 lb. Frozen 1,757,930 lb. and Fancy Meats 99,000 lb. Including an estimate of 25,000 lb. the Grand Total was 2,079,734 lb. These figures show a decrease of 969 thousand lb. from last month. Last year there was a similar movement of 300 thousand lb.

LARD The total stocks amounted to 4,153,625 lb. These stocks were 128 thousand lb. more than last month and 1.6 million lb. more than last year.

EDIBLE TALLOW Stocks of edible tallow on July 1 were 1,858,070 lb. a decrease of 614 thousand pounds from last month and an increase of 363 thousand lb. over last year's holdings.
