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STOCKS OF MEAT, LARD AND TALLOW - JANUARY 1, 1951

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

TOTAL MEAT STOCKS

The total of all meats in stock at January 1, 1951 amounted to 59,428,000 lb. as compared with 62,573,000 lb. last month and 70,210,000 lb. a year ago. A summary of stocks at December 1, 1950 by kinds of meat will be found on page 18 of this report.

COLD STORAGE

Total meats in cold storage at January 1, amounted to 33,551,000 lb. as compared with 28,661,000 lb. last month and 33,534,000 lb. at January 1, 1950. Current frozen holdings included 11,421,000 lb. of pork, 13,040,000 lb. beef, 2,685,000 lb. veal and 3,605,000 lb. mutton and lamb. The remaining 2,800,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meats held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

FRESH

Stocks of fresh meats (not frozen) at January 1 were 11,042,000 pounds compared with 16,868,000 lb. a month earlier and 13,079,000 lb. on January 1, 1950. The January 1 stocks consisted of 3,019,000 lb. pork, 6,376,000 lb. beef, 266,000 lb. veal and 111,000 lb. mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 1,270,000 lb.

CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meat, cured and in cure at January 1, 1951 were 14,835,000 lb. as compared with 17,044,000 lb. and 23,597,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 13,355,000 lb. pork, 530,000 lb. beef and an estimate of 950,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

LARD

The total stocks amounted to 3,131,000 lb. These stocks were 800 thousand pounds more than last month and 883, thousand pounds less than January 1, 1950.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on January 1, were 1,502,000 lb. as compared with 1,136,000 lb. last month and 2,248,000 lb. on January 1, 1950.
