#### SOURCE AND CONTENT

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frozen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales' outlets by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Census of Industry and Merchandising Division of the Bureau of Statistics, the latest available information appears on page 1 of this report.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau not later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement with the Industrial and Development Council of Canadian Meat Packers the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocs held for large packers.

#### MAY 1, 1954

#### TOTAL MEAT STOCKS

The total of all meats in stocks at May 1, 1954 amounted to 75,771,000 lb. as compared with 74,764,000 lb. last month and I22,819,000 lb. a year ago. A summary of stocks at April 1, 1953 by kinds of meat will be found on page 18 of this report. In addition there were 1,526,000 lb. of imported meat.

#### COLD STORAGE

Total meat in cold storage at May 1 amounted to 46,054,000 lb. as compared with 41,712,000 lb. last month and 92,064,000 lb. at May 1, 1953. Current frozen holdings included 29,974,000 lb. of pork, 10,119,000 lb. of beef, 3,143,000 lb. of veal and 1,938,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 880,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meats held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

#### FRESH

Stocks of fresh meats (not Frozen) at May 1 were 18,105,000 lb. as compared with 17,242,000 lb. a month earlier and 17,142,000 lb. on May 1,1953. The May 1 stocks consisted of 5,018,000 lb. of pork, 11,073,000 lb. of beef, 1,354,000 lb. veal and 120,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 540,000 lb.

#### CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meat, cured and in cure, at May 1, 1954 were 11,612,000 lb. as compared with 15,810,000 lb. and 13,613,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 11,036,000 lb. of pork, 356,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 220,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

#### LARD

The total stocks on April 1, 1954 were 5,481,000 lb. as compared with 4,257,000 lb. on March 1 and 9,786,000 lb. at April 1, 1953.

#### EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on April 1 were 3,765,000 lb. as compared with 3,822,000 lb. on March 1 and 4,076,000 lb. at April 1, 1953.

<sup>1/</sup> This report does not include stocks of canned meats. Stocks of these products at March 1, 1954 the latest available data, were 29,727,000 lb. of which 20,916,000 pounds were canned pork products 6,796,000 lb. canned beef and 2,015,000 lb. other canned meat products.
