
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STOCKS OF MEAT AND LARD

JULY, 1955

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DOMINION BUREAU OF STATISTICS

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SOURCE AND CONTENT

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frozen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales' outlets by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Census of Industry and Merchandising Division of the Bureau of Statistics, the latest available information appears on page 1 of this report.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau not later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement with the Industrial and Development Council of Canadian Meat Packers the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocs held for large packers.

TOTAL MEAT STOCKS

The total of domestic meat stocks at July 1, 1955 amounted to 72,448,000 lb. as compared with 74,899,000 lb. last month and 78,143,000 lb. a year ago. A summary of stocks at June 1, 1954 by kinds of meat will be found on page 18 of this report. In addition there were 2,456,000 lb. of imported meat. This total consisted of 526,000 lb. of beef and 1,930,000 lb. of lamb.

COLD STORAGE

Total meat in cold storage at July 1 amounted to 40,242,000 lb. as compared with 44,122,000 lb. last month and 49,161,000 lb. at July 1, 1954. Current frozen holdings included 25,640,000 lb. of pork, 9,285,000 lb. of beef, 3,963,000 lb. of veal and 1,024,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 330,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meats held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

FRESH

Stocks of fresh meat (not Frozen) at July 1 were 18,437,000 lb. as compared with 17,926,000 lb. a month earlier and 16,419,000 lb. on July 1, 1954. The July 1 stocks consisted of 5,254,000 lb. of pork 11,354,000 lb. of beef, 1,429,000 lb. veal and 130,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 270,000 lb.

CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meats, cured and in cure, at July 1, 1955 were 13,769,000 lb. as compared with 12,851,000 lb. and 12,563,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 13,285,000 lb. of pork, 374,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 110,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

LARD

The total stocks on July 1, 1955 were 7,322,000 lb. as compared with 7,704,000 lb. on June 1 and 6,414,000 lb. at July 1, 1954.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on July 1 were 4,939,000 lb. as compared with 4,656,000 lb. on June 1 and 2,808,000 lb. at July 1, 1954.

^{1/} This report does not include stocks of canned meats. Stocks of these products at May 1, 1955 the latest available data, were 23,458,000 lb. of which 10,892,000 lb. were canned pork products 10,033,000 lb. canned beef and 2,533,000 lb. other canned meat products.
