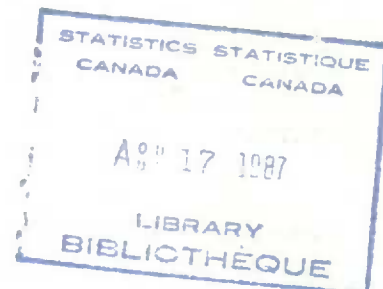

# STOCKS OF MEAT AND LARD

JUNE, 1956

Memorandum

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## SOURCE AND CONTENT

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frozen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales' outlets, by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Census of Industry and Merchandising Division of the Bureau of Statistics, the latest available information appears on page 1 of this report.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau not later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement with the Meat Packers Council of Canada the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocks held for the packers reporting under the arrangement mentioned above.

TOTAL MEAT STOCKS

The total stocks of meat of domestic origin at June 1, 1956 amounted to 88,981,000 lb. as compared with 90,733,000 lb. last month and 75,585,000 lb. a year ago. A summary of stocks at May 1, 1955 by kinds of meat will be found on page 18 of this report. In addition there were 1,857,000 lb. of imported meat. This total consisted of 129,000 lb. of beef and 1,728,000 lb. of lamb.

COLD STORAGE

Total meat in cold storage at June 1, amounted to 56,957,000 lb. as compared with 58,956,000 lb. last month and 44,667,000 lb. at June 1, 1955. Current frozen holdings included 35,418,000 lb. of pork, 15,244,000 lb. of beef, 4,361,000 lb. of veal and 1,824,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 110,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meat held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

FRESH

Stocks of fresh meat (not Frozen) at June 1, were 18,807,000 lb. as compared with 19,310,000 lb. a month earlier and 17,964,000 lb. on June 1, 1955. The June 1 stocks consisted of 5,361,000 lb. of pork, 11,488,000 lb. of beef, 1,436,000 lb. of veal and 152,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 370,000 lb.

CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meats, cured and in cure, at June 1, 1956 were 13,217,000 lb. as compared with 12,467,000 lb. and 12,954,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 12,562,000 lb. of pork, 585,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 70,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

LARD

The total stocks on June 1, 1956 were 9,471,000 lb. as compared with 9,225,000 lb. on May 1 and 7,712,000 lb. at June 1, 1955.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on June 1 were 6,202,000 lb. as compared with 5,487,000 lb. on May 1 and 4,650,000 lb. at June 1, 1955.

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1/ This report does not include stocks of canned meats. Stocks of these products at April 1, 1956 the latest available data, were 23,480,000 lb. of which 6,835,000 lb. were canned pork products 13,665,000 lb. canned beef and 2,980,000 lb. other canned meat products.

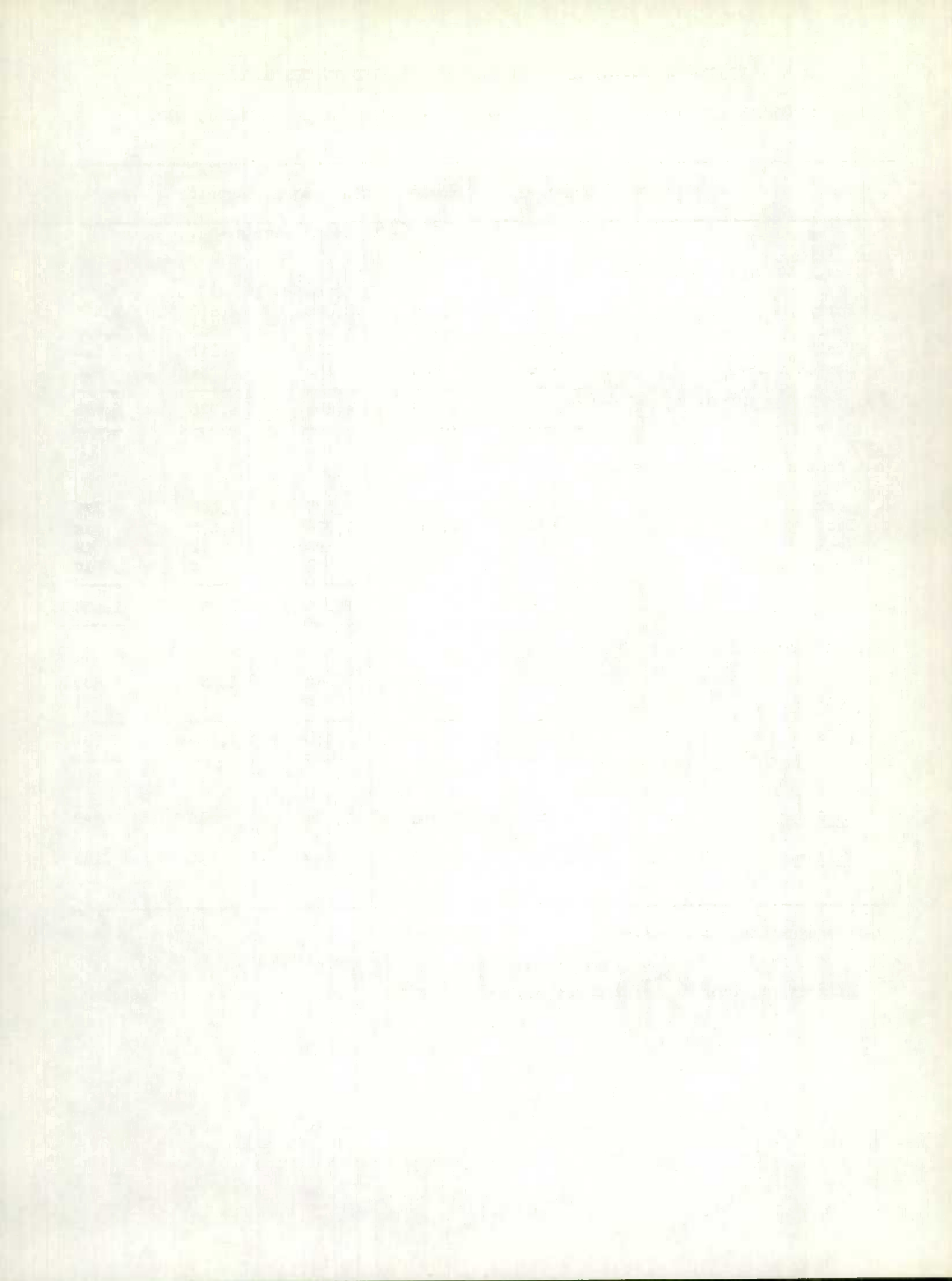
