SOURCE AND CONTENT

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frezen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales' outlets by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Census of Industry and Merchandising Division of the Bureau of Statistics, the latest available information appears on page 1 of this report.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau not later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement, made with the industry through the Meat Packers Council of Canada, the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocks held for large packers.

STOCKS OF MEAT 1/ AND LARD

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Gold Storage Warehouses

May 1, 1959

COLD STORAGE

Total meat in cold storage at May 1, 1959 amounted to 112,798,000 lb. as compared with 93,884,000 lb. last month and 44,420,000 lb. at May 1, 1958. Current frozen holdings included 91,532,000 lb. of pork, 15,764,000 lb. of beef, 2,108,000 lb. of veal and 2,384,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 1,010,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meat held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

FRESH

Stocks of fresh meat (not Frozen) at May 1, were 22,154,000 lb. as compared with 22,053,000 lb. a month earlier and 20,369,000 lb. on May 1, 1958. The May stocks consisted of 7,554,000 lb. of pork, 12,630,000 lb. of beef, 1,130,000 lb. of veal and 130,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 710,000 lb.

CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meat, cured and in cure, at May 1, were 10,095,000 lb. as compared with 9,980,000 lb. and 9,385,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 9,442,000 lb. of pork, 483,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 170,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

TOTAL MEAT STOCKS

The total stocks of meat of domestic origin at May 1, 1959 amounted to 145,047,000 lb. as compared with 125,917,000 lb. last month and 74,174,000 lb. a year ago. In addition there were 3,032,000 lb. of imported meat. This total consisted of 391,000 lb. of beef, 41,000 lb. veal and 2,600,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. A summary of stocks at April 1, 1959 by kinds of meat will be found on page 20 of this report.

LARD

The total stocks on May 1, 1959 were 10,307,000 lb. as compared with 8,762,000 lb. on April 1, 1959 and 8,166,000 lb. at May 1, 1958.

EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on May 1, 1959 were 4,345,000 lb. as compared with 4,205,000 lb. on April 1, 1959 and 5,250,000 lb. at May 1, 1958.

This report does not include stocks of canned meats. Stocks of those products at March 1, 1959, the latest available data, were 15,037,000 lb. of which 7,140,000 lb. were the canned pork products, 4,255,000 lb. canned beef and 3.642,000 lb. other canned meat products.
