#### SOURCE AND CONTENT

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frozen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales' outlets by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Census of Industry and Merchandising Division of the Bureau of Statistics, the latest available information appears on page 1 of this report.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau not later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement, made with the industry through the Meat Packers Council of Canada, the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocks held for large packers.

# STOCKS OF MEAT 1/ AND LARD

Held by Fackers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses
January 1, 1960

#### COLD STORACE

Total meat in cold storage at January 1, 1960 amounted to 66,677,000 lb. as compared with 69,683,000 lb. last month and 63,839,000 lb. at January 1, 1959. Current frozen holdings included 42,670,000 lb. of pork, 16,367,000 lb. of beef, 3,309,000 lb. of veal and 2,801,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 1,530,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meat held by firms whose reports were not received in time.

# FRESH

Stocks of fresh meat (not Frozen) at January 1 were 20,245,000 lb. as compared with 21,615,000 lb. a month earlier and 18,626,000 lb. on January 1, 1959. The January stock consisted of 7,943,000 lb. of pork, 11,023,000 lb. of beef, 596,000 lb. of veal and 163,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 520,000 lb.

#### CURED AND IN CURE

Stocks of meat, cured and in cure, at January 1, were 7,279,000 lb. as compared with 11,656,000 lb. and 9,027,000 lb. last month and a year ago respectively. The current total consisted of 6,737,000 lb. of pork, 382,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 160,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

# TOTAL MEAN SPOCKS

The total stocks of meat of domestic origin at January 1, 1960 amounted to 94,201,000 lb. as compared with 102,954,000 lb. last month and 91,542,000 lb. a year ago. In addition there were 4,705,000 lb. of imported meat. This total consisted of 1,475,000 lb. of beef, 183,000 lb. of veal, 1,485,000 lb. of mutton and 1,562,000 lb. of lamb. A summary of stocks at December 1, 1959 by kinds of meat will be found on page 20 of this report.

## LARD

The total stocks on January 1, 1960 were 7,822,000 lb. as compared with 5,305,000 lb. on December 1, 1959 and 8,608,000 lb. at January 1, 1959.

#### EDIBLE TALLOW

Stocks of edible tallow on January 1, 1960 were 3,399,000 lb. as compared with 2,859,000 lb. on December 1, 1959 and 4,189,000 lb. at January 1, 1959.

<sup>1/</sup> This report does not include stocks of canned meats. Stocks of those products at November 1, 1959, the latest available data, were 10,202,000 lb. of which 3,154,000 lb. were the canned pork products, 4,217,000 lb. canned beef and 2,831,000 lb. other canned meat products.
