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#### STOCKS OF MEAT AND LARD

Source and Content

This report contains data on the stocks of fresh, frozen and cured meats and stocks of lard and edible tallow held by meat packers and their sales outlets by wholesale butchers, abattoirs and cold storage warehouses. Inventories are taken only at the wholesale level. Canned meat stocks are collected by the Industry Division of the Bureau of Statistics.

Inventory statement forms are supplied to each firm with instructions to complete and mail in time to reach the Bureau no later than the sixth of the month. Firms are required to report all stocks in their own establishment or in specially rented rooms elsewhere as at the opening of the first business day of the month. By a special arrangement, made with the industry through the Meat Packers Council of Canada, the larger meat packers report total meat inventories regardless of where held and are also permitted to submit figures of their period-end inventory providing such inventory has been taken within three days prior to the month end. Cold Storage warehouses are instructed not to report stocks held for large packers.

## STOCKS OF MEAT AND LARD

Held by Packers, Abattoirs, Wholesale Butchers and Cold Storage Warehouses

December 1, 1963

#### COLD STORAGE:

Total meat in cold storage at the opening of the first business day of December 1963 amounted to 46,095,000 lb. as compared with 43,213,000 lb. last month and 37,261,000 lb. a year ago. Current frozen holdings included 16,574,000 lb. of pork, 21,603,000 lb. of beef, 4,272,000 lb. of veal and 2,931,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. The remaining 715,000 lb. was the estimated quantity of all frozen meat held by firms whose reports were not received on time.

## FRESH:

Stocks of fresh meat (not frozen) were 24,290,000 lb. as compared with 22,726,000 lb. last month and 21,003,000 lb. at December 1, 1962. The December stocks consisted of 6,773,000 lb. of pork, 15,407,000 lb. of beef, 1,158,000 lb. of veal and 262,000 lb. of mutton and lamb. Estimated stocks for outstanding firms amounted to 690,000 lb.

#### CURED AND IN CURE:

Stocks of meat, cured and in cure, were 9,697,000 lb. as compared with 8,571,000 lb. and 8,707,000 lb. last month and a year ago, respectively. The current total consisted of 9,136,000 lb. of pork, 416,000 lb. of beef and an estimate of 145,000 lb. not classified as to kind.

#### TOTAL MEAT STOCKS:

The total stocks of meat of domestic origin amounted to 80,082,000 lb. as compared with 74,510,000 lb. last month and 66,971,000 lb. a year ago. In addition there were 11,186,000 lb. of imported meat. This total consisted of 4,155,000 lb. of beef, 436,000 lb. of veal, 2,707,000 lb. of mutton and 3,888,000 lb. of lamb. A summary of stocks for November 1963 by kinds of meat will be found on page 20 of this report.

#### LARD:

The total stocks were 4,271,000 lb. as compared with 4,499,000 lb. last month and 5,208,000 lb. at the same date last year.

#### EDIBLE TALLOW:

Stocks of edible tallow were 2,694,000 lb. as compared with 2,436,000 lb. last month and 3,118,000 lb. at the same date last year.


