#### NOTES

In the first ten four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 662,803,108 pounds, a decrease of only 876,709 pounds from the output of the same months in 1938.

## RAW SUGAR

The amount of Raw Sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1939, was 78,038,093 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to October 7 was 604,401,197 pounds, making 682,439,290 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 678,649,196 pounds, leaving only 3,790,094 pounds on hand in the refineries on October 7, 1939, compared with 62,363,596 pounds at the end of the last four-week period, ended September 9, and 73,175,087 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 58,573,504 pounds from the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and 76,686,483 pounds less than for the same period in 1938.

### REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of Refined Sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1 last totalled 255,074,475 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 587,888,835 pounds, and into yellow and brown 74,914,275 pounds, totalling 662,803,108 pounds for the period from January 1 to October 7, 1939. This makes a grand total of 917,877,583 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 784,852,174 pounds of granulated and 95,629,845 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 880,482,019 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 39,993,162 pounds compared with 71,287,572 pounds shown on the previous report and 116,679,645 pounds on the same date a year ago.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 31,294,410 pounds from the figures published in the Bureau's last report on September 9 and 76,686,483 pounds less than those of the same date a year ago.

Since this report was compiled, receipts of raw sugar at the refineries have replenished stocks to normal.
