NOTES

In the first eleven four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 809,120,369 pounds, a decrease of 13,054,345 pounds from the output of the same months in 1938.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of Raw Sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1939, was 78,038,093 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to November 4 was 765,381,886 pounds, making 843,419,979 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 763,353,243 pounds, leaving 80,066,736 pounds on hand in the refineries on November 4, 1939, compared with 3,790,094 pounds at the end of the last four-week period, ended October 7, and 89,644,655 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 76,276,642 pounds over the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and 9,577,919 pounds less than for the same period in 1938.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of Refined Sugar (Cane and Beet) in the refineries on January 1 last totalled 255,074,475 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 723,770,686 pounds, and into yellow and brown 85,349,683 pounds, totalling 809,120,369 pounds for the period from January 1 to November 4, 1939. This makes a grand total of 1,064,194,844 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 881,920,610 pounds of granulated and 107,626,535 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 989,547,145 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 79,748,797 pounds compared with 39,993,162 pounds shown on the previous report and 192,870,248 pounds on the same date a year ago.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 39,755,635 pounds over the figures published in the Bureau's last report on October 7 and 113,121,451 pounds less than those of the same date a year ago.

From the above, it will be observed that the refineries increased their stocks of raw sugar over the last four-week period so that it is only slightly less than last year's corresponding total. Refined sugar also shows largely increased stocks over the last four-week period, but is 113,121,451 pounds less than the same date a year ago.
