

## NOTES

In the first twelve four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 999,510,880 pounds, an increase of 33,318,105 pounds from the output of the same months in 1938.

### RAW SUGAR

The amount of Raw Sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1939, was 78,038,093 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to December 2, was 926,871,360 pounds making 1,004,909,453 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 888,908,808 pounds, leaving 116,000,645 pounds on hand in the refineries on December 2, 1939, compared with 80,066,736 pounds at the end of the last four-week period, ended November 4, and 76,421,150 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 35,933,909 pounds over the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and 39,579,495 pounds more than for the same period in 1938.

### REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of Refined Sugar (Cane and Beet) in the refineries on January 1 last totalled 255,074,475 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 893,162,702 pounds and into yellow and brown 106,348,178 pounds, totalling 999,510,880 pounds for the period from January 1 to December 2, 1939. This makes a grand total of 1,254,585,355 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 942,806,488 pounds of granulated and 118,942,425 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,061,748,913 pounds. The stock on hand with small amounts purchased was 197,947,540 pounds compared with 79,748,797 pounds shown on the previous report and 250,922,313 pounds on the same date a year ago.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 118,198,743 pounds over the figures published in the Bureau's last report on November 4 and 52,974,773 pounds less than those of the same date a year ago.

From the above it will be observed that the refineries increased their stocks of raw sugar over the last four-week period and is more than last year's corresponding total. Refined sugar also shows largely increased stocks over the last four-week period, but is 52,974,773 pounds less than the same date a year ago.

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
