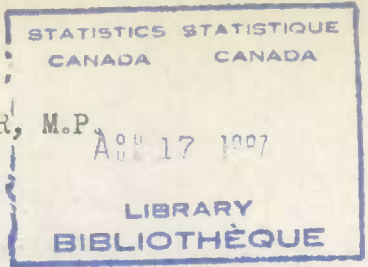
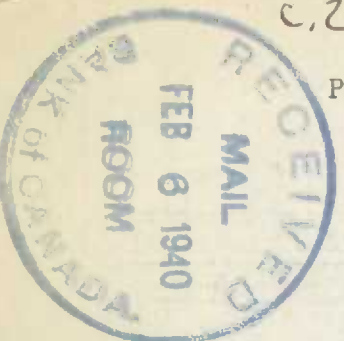

### NOTES

During the calendar year 1939 Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 1,125,491,367 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 93,655,267 pounds over the output of the year 1938.

### RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1939 was 78,038,093 pounds, while the quantity received from January 1 to December 31, 1939 was 984,701,315 pounds making 1,062,739,408 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 988,213,258 pounds leaving 74,526,150 pounds on hand in the refineries on December 31, 1939 compared with 116,000,645 pounds at the end of the last four-week period, ended December 2, and 78,038,093 on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 41,474,495 pounds from the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and 3,511,943 pounds less than for the same period in 1938.

### REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1 last totalled 255,074,475 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 1,003,134,812 pounds and into yellow and brown 122,357,055 pounds, totalling 1,125,491,867 pounds for the period from January 1 to December 31, 1939. This makes a grand total of 1,380,566,342 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 1,008,643,738 pounds of granulated and 129,066,647 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,137,710,385 pounds. The stock on hand with small amounts purchased was 248,461,420 pounds compared with 197,947,540 pounds shown on the previous report and 255,074,475 pounds on the same date a year ago.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 50,513,880 pounds over the figures published in the Bureau's last report on December 2, and 6,613,055 pounds less than those of the same date a year ago.

From the above it will be observed that the refineries show a decrease in their stocks of raw sugar from the last four-week period and is slightly less than last year's corresponding total. Refined sugar also shows largely increased stocks over the last four-week period, but is 6,613,055 pounds less than the same date last year.

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
