#### NOTES

In the eleven four-week periods of the present year ending November 2, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 886,565,423 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 77,445,054 pounds over the same period last year.

## RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to November 2 was 906,066,255 pounds making 980,592,405 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 850,445,085 pounds leaving 130,147,320 pounds on hand in the refineries on November 2, 1940, compared with 145,591,697 pounds at the end of the last fourweek period and 80,066,736 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 13,444,377 pounds from last report and increased 50,080,584 pounds over the same period last year.

## REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 787,187,585 pounds and into yellow and brown 99,377,838 pounds totalling 886,565,423 pounds for the period January 1 to November 2, 1940. This makes a grand total of 1,135,026,843 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 842,293,520 pounds of granulated; 101,897,501 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 944,191,041 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 190,970,617 pounds compared with 111,661,733 pounds shown on previous report and 79,748,797 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 79,308,884 pounds over last report and an increase of 111,221,820 pounds over the same date last year.
