

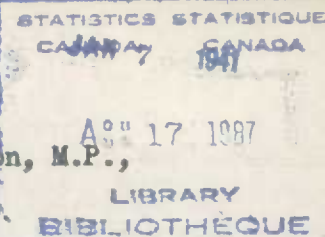

NOTES

In the twelve four-week periods of the present year ending November 30, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 1,050,570,832 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 51,059,952 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to November 30 was 1,022,024,420 pounds, making 1,096,550,570 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 951,241,635 pounds leaving 145,308,935 pounds on hand in the refineries on November 30, 1940, compared with 130,147,320 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 116,000,645 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 15,161,615 pounds over last report and increased 29,308,290 pounds over the same period last year.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated was 933,589,472 pounds and into yellow and brown 116,981,360 pounds totalling 1,050,570,832 pounds for the period January 1, to November 30, 1940. This makes a grand total of 1,299,032,252 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 921,047,115 pounds of granulated, 116,157,699 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 1,037,204,814 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 261,986,253 pounds compared with 190,970,617 pounds shown on last report and 197,947,540 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 71,015,636 pounds over last report and an increase of 64,038,713 pounds over the same date last year.
