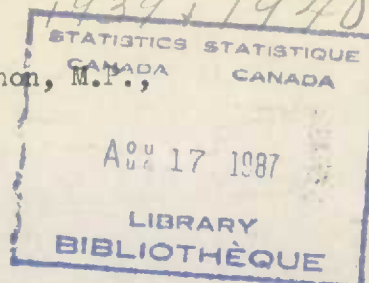

NOTES

During the calendar year 1940 Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 1,137,792,237 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 12,300,370 pounds over the output of the year 1939.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received from January 1 to December 31, 1940 was 1,058,522,694 pounds making 1,133,048,844 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 992,078,230 pounds leaving 140,970,614 pounds on hand in the refineries on December 31, 1940 compared with 145,308,935 pounds at the end of the last four-week period, ended November 30, and 74,526,150 on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 4,338,321 pounds from the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and increased 66,444,464 pounds over the same period in 1939.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1 last totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 1,012,743,714 pounds and into yellow and brown 125,048,523 pounds, totalling 1,137,792,237 pounds for the period from January 1 to December 31, 1940. This makes a grand total of 1,386,253,657 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 982,228,158 pounds of granulated and 125,649,520 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,107,877,678 pounds. The stock on hand with small amounts purchased was 278,542,439 pounds compared with 261,986,253 pounds shown on last report and 248,461,420 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 16,556,186 pounds over the figures published in the Bureau's last report on November 30, and an increase of 30,081,019 pounds over the figures published on the same date a year ago.

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
