NOTES

In the first two four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 87,886,708 pounds, an increase of 46,306,509 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to February 24 was 96,555,325 pounds making 171,081,475 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 88,259,572 pounds, leaving 82,821,903 pounds on hand in the refineries on February 24, 1940 compared with 87,118,868 pounds at the end of last four-week period and 76,344,754 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 4,296,965 pounds from last report and decreased 6,477,149 pounds from the same period last year.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 76,660,195 pounds and into yellow and brown 11,226,513 pounds totalling 87,886,708 pounds for the period from January 1, to February 24, 1940. This makes a grand total of 336,348,128 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 147,134,364 pounds of granulated and 17,733,260 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 164,867,624 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 171,491,484 pounds compared with 192,884,644 pounds shown on previous report and 181,142,630 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 21,393,160 from the last report and a decrease of 9,651,146 pounds from the same period last year.
