NOTES

In the first three four-week periods of the present year, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 122,751,496 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 58,301,906 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to March 23 was 156,968,457 making 231,494,607 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 126,503,819 pounds, leaving 104,990,788 pounds on hand in the refineries on March 23, 1940 compared with 82,821,903 pounds at the end of last four-week period and 85,298,884 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 22,168,885 pounds over last report and increased 19,691,904 over same period last year.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 243,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 107,784,314 pounds and into yellow and brown 14,967,182 pounds totalling 122,751,496 pounds for the period from January 1 to March 23, 1940. This makes a grand total of 371,212,916 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 193,036,873 pounds of granulated and 25,836,529 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 223,873,402 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 147,358,494 pounds compared with 171,491,484 pounds shown on previous report and 141,516,572 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 24,132,990 pounds from last report and an increase of 5,841,922 pounds over the same period last year.
