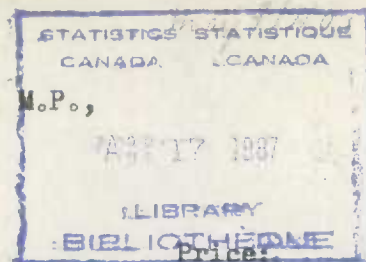

NOTES

In the first sixteen weeks of the present year, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 182,461,630 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 72,910,968 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to April 20 was 197,462,954 pounds, making 271,989,104 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 189,011,326 pounds, leaving 82,977,778 pounds on hand in the refineries on April 20, 1940 compared with 104,990,788 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 78,328,053 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 22,013,010 pounds from last report and increased 4,649,725 pounds over last year.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 159,188,490 pounds and into yellow and brown 23,273,140 pounds totalling 182,461,630 pounds for the period from January 1 to April 20, 1940. This makes a grand total of 430,923,050 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 273,430,046 pounds of granulated and 36,802,917 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 310,232,963 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 120,711,902 pounds compared with 147,358,494 pounds shown on previous report and 109,971,775 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 26,646,592 pounds from last report and an increase of 10,740,127 pounds over the same period last year.

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
