#### NOTES

In the five four-week periods of the present year ending May 18, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 276,339,768 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 68,493,883 pounds over the same period last year.

# Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to May 18 was 310,742,460 pounds, making 385,268,610 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 292,765,211 pounds, leaving 92,503,399 pounds on hand in the refineries on May 18, 1940 compared with 82,977,778 pounds at the end of the last four week period and 123,912,891 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 9,525,621 pounds over last report and decreased 31,409,492 pounds from same period last year.

# Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 241,827,602 pounds and into yellow and brown 34,512,166 pounds totalling 276,339,768 pounds for the period January 1 to May 18, 1940. This makes a grand total of 524,801,188 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 365,275,164 pounds of granulated and 47,418,569 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 412,693,733 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 112,136,470 pounds compared with 120,711,902 pounds shown on previous report and 129,071,034 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 8,575,432 pounds from last report and a decrease of 16,934,564 pounds from the same date last year.
