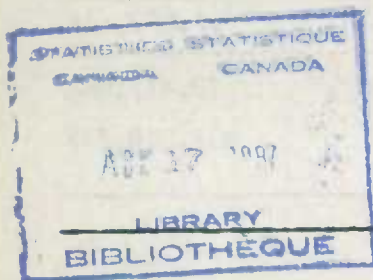

NOTES

In the six four-week periods of the present year ending June 15, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 383,849,627 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 81,898,714 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to June 15 was 416,517,831 pounds making 491,043,981 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 404,967,711 pounds, leaving 86,076,270 pounds on hand in the refineries on June 15, 1940 compared with 92,503,399 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 124,463,287 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 6,427,129 pounds from last report and decreased 38,387,017 pounds from the same period last year.

Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 337,035,892 pounds and into yellow and brown 46,813,735 pounds totalling 383,849,627 pounds for the period January 1 to June 15, 1940. This makes a grand total of 632,311,047 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 456,902,075 pounds of granulated and 58,117,018 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 515,019,093 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 117,330,969 pounds compared with 112,136,470 pounds shown on previous report and 152,709,778 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 5,194,499 pounds over last report and a decrease of 35,378,809 pounds from the same date last year.



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
