NOTES

In the seven four-week periods of the present year ending July 13, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 483,403,070 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 95,614,327 pounds over the same period last year.

Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to July 13 was 517,741,452 pounds making 592,267,602 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 505,207,415 pounds, leaving 87,060,187 pounds on hand in the refineries on July 13, 1940 compared with 86,076,270 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 125,500,539 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 983,917 pounds over last report and decreased 38,440,352 pounds from the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 424,202,790 pounds and into yellow and brown 59,200,280 pounds totalling 483,403,070 pounds for the period January 1 to July 13, 1940. This makes a grand total of 731,864,490 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 534,749,555 pounds of granulated and 65,620,582 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 600,370,137 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 131,538,418 pounds compared with 117,330,969 pounds shown on previous report and 132,662,543 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 14,207,449 pounds over last report and a decrease of 1,124,125 pounds from the same date last year.

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
