#### NOTES

In the nine four-week periods of the present year ending September 7, 1940, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 620,345,592 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 59,147,046 pounds over the same period last year.

### Raw Sugar

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1940 was 74,526,150 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to September 7 was 684,117,186 pounds making 758,643,336 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar accounted for 649,198,030 pounds leaving 109,445,306 pounds on hand in the refineries on September 7, 1940, compared with 96,369,812 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 62,363,598 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 13,075,494 pounds over last report and increased 47,081,708 pounds over the same period last year.

## Refined Sugar

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1940 totalled 248,461,420 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 547,033,157 pounds and into yellow and brown 73,312,435 pounds totalling 620,345,592 pounds for the period January 1 to September 7, 1940. This makes a grand total of 868,807,012 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 672,408,518 pounds of granulated and 79,244,368 pounds of yellow and brown, accounting for 751,652,886 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 117,256,441 pounds compared with 122,228,804 pounds shown on the previous report and 71,287,572 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 4,972,363 pounds from last report and an increase of 45,968,869 pounds from the same date last year.
