### NOTES



During the first four weeks of January 1941, Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 37,921,156 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 16,807,231 pounds from the same period in 1940.

#### RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received since January 1 was 28,425,363 pounds making 169,395,977 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 24,943,020 pounds leaving 144,452,957 pounds on hand at the end of the first four-week period ended January 25, 1941, compared with 87,118,868 pounds at the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 57,334,089 pounds over last year's figure.

### REFINED SUGAR

The amount of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 was 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 33,517,883 pounds and into yellow and brown 4,403,273 pounds totalling 37,921,156 pounds. This makes a grand total of 316,463,595 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 44,226,485 pounds of granulated and 6,195,122 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 50,421,607 pounds. The stock on hand with small amounts purchased was 266,050,488 pounds compared with 192,884,644 pounds on the same date last year.
