### NOTES

In the first ten four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 770,367,254 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 65,347,360 pounds over the same period last year.

## RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to October 4 was 766,303,243 pounds making 907,773,357 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 704,423,026 pounds leaving 113,345,831 pounds on hand in the refineries on October 4, 1941 compared with 127,111,149 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 143,591,697 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 13,765,313 pounds from the last report and were 30,245,866 pounds less than at the same period last year.

### REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 687,933,491 pounds and into yellow and brown 91,433,763 pounds totalling 779,367,254 pounds for the period from January 1 to October 4, 1941. This makes a grand total of 1,057,909,693 pounds. Sales for donestic consumption and for export for the above period were 337,111,393 pounds of granulated and 93,297,170 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 930,408,563 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 127,693,660 pounds compared with 133,666,696 pounds shown on last report and 111,661,733 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 5,973,036 pounds from the last report and an increase of 16,031,927 pounds over stocks at the same period last year.
