In the first eleven four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 941,580,290 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 55,014,867 pounds over the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,814 pounds while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to November 1 was 842,506,875 pounds making 983,477,487 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 900,605,110 pounds leaving 82,872,377 pounds on hand in the refineries on November 1, 1941 compared with 113,345,831 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 130,147,320 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 30,473,454 pounds from the last report and were 47,274,943 pounds less than at the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 835,216,022 pounds and into yellow and brown 105,754,268 pounds totalling 941,580,290 pounds for the period from January 1 to November 1, 1941. This makes a grand total of 1,220,122,729 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 906,841,098 pounds of granulated and 103,765,219 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,010,606,315 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 209,711,444 pounds compared with 127,693,660 pounds shown on last report and 190,970,617 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 82,017,784 pounds from the last report and an increase of 18,740,827 pounds over stocks at the same period last year.
