NOTES

In the first twelve four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 1,109,532,309 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 58,961,477 pounds over the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The kmount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds while the quantity received from January 1 to November 29 was 998,235,684 pounds making 1,139,206,298 pounds for manufacture. Neltings and sales of raw sugar account for 1,007,718,073 pounds leaving 131,488,225 pounds on hand in the refineries on November 29, 1941 compared with 82,872,377 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 145,308,935 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 48,615,848 pounds over the last report and were 13,820,710 pounds less than the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated was 987,340,020 pounds and into yellow and brown 122,192,289 pounds totalling 1,109,532,309 pounds for the period from January 1 to November 29, 1941. This makes a grand total of 1,388,074,748 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 973,994,286 pounds of granulated and 116,549,935 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,090,544,221 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 297,651,927 pounds compared with the revised figure of 209,615,423 pounds on last report and 261,986,253 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 83,036,504 pounds over the revised figure of last report and an increase of 35,665,674 pounds over the stock at the same period last year.
