NOTES

During the calendar year 1941 Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 1,199,719,338 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 61,927,101 pounds over the output of the year 1940.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received from January 1 to December 31, 1941 was 1,035,584,150 pounds making 1,176,554,764 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 1,054,787,205 pounds leaving 121,767,659 pounds on hand in the refineries on December 31, 1941 compared with 131,483,225 pounds at the end of last four-week period, and 140,970,614 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 3,720,566 pounds from the amount in store at the end of the last four-week period and decreased 19,202,955 pounds from the same period in 1940.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 1,067,655,293 pounds and into yellow and brown 132,064,045 pounds, totalling 1,199,719,338 pounds for the period from January 1 to December 31, 1941. This makes a grand total of 1,478,261,777 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 1,031,094,955 pounds of granulated and 127,239,414 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 1,158,334,369 pounds. The stock on hand with small amounts purchased was 320,085,258 pounds compared with 297,651,927 pounds shown on last report and 278,542,439 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 22,433,331 pounds over the figures published in the Bureau's last report, and an increase of 41,542,819 pounds over the figures published on the same date last year.
