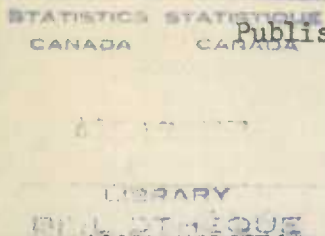

NOTES

In the first two four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 81,234,157 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 6,652,551 pounds from the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to February 22 was 36,861,038 pounds making 177,831,652 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 72,147,771 pounds, leaving 105,683,881 pounds on hand in the refineries on February 22, 1941 compared with 144,452,957 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 82,821,903 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 38,769,076 pounds from the last report and increased 22,861,978 pounds over the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 71,785,544 pounds and into yellow and brown 9,448,613 pounds totalling 81,234,157 pounds for the period from January 1 to February 22, 1941. This makes a grand total of 359,776,596 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 115,171,982 pounds of granulated and 15,882,061 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 131,054,043 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 228,736,053 pounds compared with 266,050,488 pounds shown on previous report and 171,491,484 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 37,314,435 pounds from the last report and an increase of 57,244,569 pounds from the same period last year.
