NOTES

In the first three four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 142,031,560 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 19,350,064 pounds over the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to March 22 was 69,324,523 pounds making 210,295,137 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 135,842,376 pounds leaving 74,452,261 pounds on hand in the refineries on March 22, 1941 compared with 105,635,831 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 104,990,738 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 31,231,620 pounds from the last report and decreased 30,553,527 pounds from the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 273,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 125,115,371 pounds and into yellow and brown 16,966,139 pounds totalling 142,031,560 pounds for the period from January 1 to March 22, 1941. This makes a grand total of 420,623,999 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 210,638,233 pounds of granulated and 27,387,725 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 238,026,013 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 132,614,636 pounds compared with 222,735,053 pounds shown on previous report and 147,358,424 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 46,121,417 pounds from the last report and an increase of 35,256,142 pounds over the same period last year.
