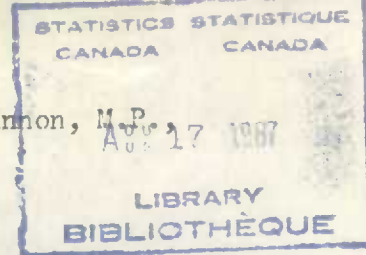

NOTES

In the first four four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 192,032,236 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 9,570,606 pounds over the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to April 19 was 117,076,288 pounds making 258,046,902 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 186,919,307 pounds leaving 71,127,595 pounds on hand in the refineries on April 19, 1941 compared with 74,452,261 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 82,977,778 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 3,324,666 pounds from the last report and decreased 11,850,183 pounds from the same date last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,430 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 167,846,581 pounds and into yellow and brown was 24,185,655 pounds totalling 192,032,236 pounds for the period from January 1 to April 19, 1941. This makes a grand total of 470,574,675 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 236,763,528 pounds of granulated and 37,306,381 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 324,074,909 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 146,518,916 pounds compared with 182,614,636 pounds shown on previous report and 120,711,902 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 36,095,720 pounds from the last report and an increase of 25,807,014 pounds over the same period last year.
