### NOTES

In the first five four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 263,580,726 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 12,753,042 pounds from the same period last year.

### RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1, to May 17 was 206,921,953 pounds making 347,892,567 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 263,237,070 pounds leaving 84,655,497 pounds on hand in the refineries on May 17, 1941 compared with 71,127,595 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 92,503,399 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 13,527,902 pounds over the last report and decreased 7,847,902 pounds from the same date last year.

### REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 229,934,531 pounds and into yellow and brown was 33,646,195 pounds totalling 263,580,726 pounds for the period from January 1 to May 17, 1941. This makes a grand total of 542,123,165 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 359,715,873 pounds of granulated and 45,068,293 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 404,784,166 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 137,370,149 pounds compared with 146,518,916 pounds shown on previous report and 112,136,470 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 9,148,767 pounds from the last report and an increase of 25,233,679 pounds over the same period last year.
