NOTES

In the first seven four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 475,729,983 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 7,673,087 pounds from the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to July 12 was 469,604,049 pounds making 610,574,663 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 484,992,795 pounds leaving 125,581,868 pounds on hand in the refineries on July 12, 1941 compared with 131,635,028 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 87,060,187 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 6,053,160 pounds from the last report and increased 38,521,681 pounds over the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 419,307,351 pounds and into yellow and brown was 56,422,632 pounds totalling 475,729,983 pounds for the period from January 1 to July 12, 1941. This makes a grand total of 754,272,422 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 528,808,995 pounds of granulated and 61,565,266 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 590,374,261 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 163,974,061 pounds compared with 158,730,130 pounds shown on previous report and 131,533,418 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 5,243,931 pounds over the last report and an increase of 32,435,643 pounds over the same period last year.
