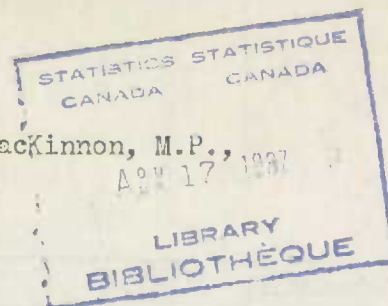

NOTES

In the first eight four-week periods of the present year Canada's ten sugar refineries manufactured 567,261,274 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 18,254,928 pounds over the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1941 was 140,970,614 pounds while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to August 9 was 599,988,249 pounds making 740,958,863 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 573,745,426 pounds leaving 164,213,437 pounds on hand in the refineries on August 9, 1941 compared with 125,581,868 pounds at the end of the last four-week period and 96,369,812 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 38,631,569 pounds over the last report and increased 67,843,625 pounds over the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The stocks of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1941 totalled 278,542,439 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 501,295,320 pounds and into yellow and brown was 65,265,954 pounds totalling 567,261,274 pounds for the period from January 1 to August 9, 1941. This makes a grand total of 845,803,713 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 649,788,490 pounds of granulated and 70,939,816 pounds of yellow and brown accounting for 700,728,306 pounds. The stock on hand together with small amounts purchased was 145,162,307 pounds compared with 163,974,061 pounds shown on last report and 122,228,804 pounds on the same date last year.

Refined sugar stocks show a decrease of 18,811,754 pounds from the last report and an increase of 22,933,503 pounds over the same period last year.
