# NOTES

During the first four-week period of 1946, Canada's sugar refineries manufactured 73,464,100 pounds of refined sugar, an increase of 5,709,162 pounds over the same period in 1945.

## RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1946 was 90,333,091 pounds while the quantity received from January 1 to January 26 was 47,648,222 making a total of 137,981,313 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 57,463,684 pounds leaving 80,517,629 pounds on hand at the end of the period compared with 96,172,343 pounds on hand at the end of the first period in 1945. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 15,654,714 pounds from the same date last year.

## REFINED SUGAR

The amount of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1946 was 183,233,178 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 66,695,704 pounds and into yellow and brown sugar was 6,768,396 pounds totalling 73,464,100 pounds. This makes a grand total of 256,697,278 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 49,401,920 pounds of granulated sugar and 6,371,323 pounds of yellow and brown sugar accounting for 55,773,243 pounds. The stock on hand at the end of this period was 200,924,035 pounds compared with 146,897,965 pounds shown at the end of the first period in 1945. The refined sugar stocks show an increase of 54,026,070 pounds from the same date last year.
