NOTES

In the first two sugar periods of the present calendar year Canada's sugar refineries manufactured 133,919,349 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 296,419 pounds from the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1946 was 90,333,091 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to February 23 was 91,930,906 pounds, making 182,263,997 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 120,662,969 pounds, leaving 61,601,028 pounds on hand in the refineries on February 23, 1946 compared with 80,517,629 pounds at the end of the first period of this year and 93,311,691 on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar decreased 18,916,601 pounds from the last report and decreased 31,710,663 pounds from the same date last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The amount of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1946 was 183,233,178 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 120,329,034 pounds and into yellow and brown sugar was 13,590,315 pounds, totalling 133,919,349 pounds for the period from January 1 to February 23, 1946. This makes a grand total of 317,152,527 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 98,395,358 pounds of granulated sugar and 13,077,692 pounds of yellow and brown sugar, accounting for 111,473,050 pounds. The stock on hand at the end of the period, together with small amounts purchased or added to stock was 205,683,858 pounds, compared with 200,924,035 pounds shown on last report and 153,483,873 pounds on the same date last year. Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 4,759,823 pounds over the last report and an increase of 52,199,985 pounds over the same date last year.
