In the first three four-week sugar periods of the present calendar year, Canada's sugar refineries manufactured 185,179,562 pounds of refined sugar, a decrease of 19,985,259 pounds from the same period last year.

RAW SUGAR

The amount of raw sugar in the different refineries throughout Canada on January 1, 1946 was 90,333,091 pounds, while the quantity received during the period from January 1 to March 25 was 149,350,030 pounds, making 239,683,121 pounds for manufacture. Meltings and sales of raw sugar account for 171,679,904 pounds, leaving 68,003,217 pounds on hand in the refinerics on March 23, 1946 compared with 61,601,028 pounds at the end of the last period and 96,500,810 pounds on the same date last year. Stocks of raw sugar increased 6,402,189 pounds over the last report and decreased 28,497,593 pounds from the same period last year.

REFINED SUGAR

The amount of refined sugar (cane and beet) in the refineries on January 1, 1946 was 183,233,178 pounds. The amount since manufactured into granulated sugar was 164,875,585 pounds and into yellow and brown sugar was 20,303,977 pounds, totalling 185,179,562 pounds for the period from January 1 to March 23, 1946. This makes a grand total of 368,412,740 pounds. Sales for domestic consumption and for export for the above period were 140,930,913 <u>1</u>/ pounds of granulated sugar and 18,253,088 pounds of yellow and brown sugar, accounting for 159,184,001^{<u>1</u>} pounds. The stock on hand at the end of the period, together with small amounts purchased or added to stock was 209,241,612 pounds, compared with 205,664,668^{<u>1</u>} pounds shown on last report and 161,422,005 pounds on the same date last year. Refined sugar stocks show an increase of 3,556,944 pounds over the last report and an increase of 47,819,607 pounds over the same date last year.
