Stocks and Consumption
of Unmanufactured Tobacco
March 1949.

Statistics of stocks, purchases and disposal of unmanufactured tobacco are collected quarterly from packers, dealers, co-operatives and other agencies. This current release covers the quarter ending March 31, 1949.

Current inventories increased to 171,201,538 standard pounds from 120,813,-048 standard pounds at December 31st last, and at the same time showed an increase of 18,317,857 standard pounds over the same period ending March 31, 1948, when the stocks on hand were reported as 152,883,-681 standard pounds. By domestic varieties, Flue-cured Bright Virginia reported 136,358,536 standard pounds, Burley 18,396,-724 standard pounds, Cigar Leaf 7,888,546 standard pounds.

In this quarter 18,987,978 standard pounds of all varieties were used in the production of Tobacco Products. Of this 363,875 standard pounds were imported types. The total domestic consumption of unmanufactured tobacco in the production of cigars, cigarettes and tobacco and snuff was 833,210, 11,110,377 and 6,680,516 (Standard pounds) respectively.

Five-year average inventories, 1934-1938 and 1938-1943 and the ten-year average for the combined period, 1934-1943 complete the data recorded and are included in Table 1. of this edition.

Stocks et consommation
de tabac non-manufacturé

Les statistiques des stocks achats et écoulement du tabac non-manufacturé sont recueillies trimestriellement des manufactures, des vendeurs, des co-opératives et autres organismes. Le présent rapport porte sur le trimestre terminé le 31 mars 1949.

Les stocks à l'heure actuelle sont de 171,201,538 livres standard, contre 120,813,048 livres standard le 31 décembre dernier. C'est une augmentation de 18,317,857 livres standard sur les stocks de 112,261,594 livres standard déclarés le 31 mars 1948. Les stocks renferment les variétés domestiques suivantes: Virginie jaune clair, 136,358,536 livres standard; Burley, 18,396,724 livres standard; et feuilles à cigare, 7,888,546 livres standard.

Les produits du tabac ont absorbé au cours du trimestre 18,987,978 livres standard de tabac de toutes variétés. Ce total comprend 363,875 livres standard de tabac importé. La consommation domestique totale de tabac non-manufacturé dans la production de cigares, de cigarettes, de tabac et de tabac à priser, est respectivement de 833,210, 11,110,-377 et 6,680,517 livres standard.

Les stocks moyens quinquennaux de 1934 à 1938 et de 1938 à 1943 et la moyenne décennale pour l'ensemble de la période, 1934-1943, complètent ces renseignements et paraissent au tableau 1 du présent rapport.
