Stocks and Consumption
of Unmanufactured Tobacco
March 1952

Statistics of stocks, purchases and disposal of unmanufactured tobacco are collected quarterly from packers, dealers, co-operatives and other agencies. This current release covers the quarter ending March 31, 1952. It should be noted that all data in this report is now expressed in actual pounds rather than standard pounds.

Current inventories increased to 213,981,295 pounds from 164,949,873 pounds at December 31st last, and also showed an increase of 21,000,000 pounds over the same period ending March 31, 1951, when the stocks on hand were reported as 193,353,837 pounds. By domestic varieties; Flue-cured Bright Virginia reported 173,518,517 pounds, Burley 20,412,597 pounds Cigar leaf 11,- 751,044 pounds.

In this quarter, 18,937,044 pounds of all varieties were used in the production of tobacco Products. Of this 426,167 pounds were imported types. The total domestic consumption of unmanufactured tobacco in the production of cigars, cigarettes and tobacco and snuff was 876,390, 10,036,956 and 7,597,531 (pounds) respectively.

Five-year average inventories, 1934-1938 and 1938-1943 and the ten-year average for the combined period, 1934-1943 complete the data recorded and are included in Table 1, of this edition. Conversion data is available on page 30 of this report.

This report contains the historical record, of the stock of unmanufactured tobacco, quantity taken from stock, total exports quantity and value of exports and total imports of raw leaf tobacco. This record, is in most instances, continuous from 1938 to 1951.


Les statistiques des stocks achats et écoulement du tabac non manufacturé sont recueillies trimestriellement des manufactures, des vendeurs, des coopératives et autres organismes. Le présent rapport porte sur le trimestre terminé le 31 mars 1952. A remarquer que les données du présent rapport sont exprimées en livres réelles et non en livres standard.

Les stocks à l'heure actuelle sont de 213,981,295 livres comparativement à 164,949,873 livres le 31 décembre dernier. C'est une augmentation de 21,000,000 livres sur les stocks de 193,353,837 livres déclarés le 31 mars 1951. Les stocks renferment les variétés domestiques suivantes; Virginie jaune clair, 173,518,517 livres; Burley, 20,412,597 livres; et feuilles à cigare, 11,751,044 livres.

Les produits du tabac ont absorbé au cours du trimestre 18,937,044 livres de tabac de toutes variétés. Ce total comprend 426,167 livres de tabac importé. La consommation domestique totale de tabac non manufacturé dans la production de cigares, de cigarettes, de tabac et de tabac à priser, est respectivement de 876,390, 10,036,- 956 et 7,597,531 livres.

Les stocks moyens quinquennaux de 1934 à 1938 et de 1938 à 1943 et la moyenne décennale pour l'ensemble de la période, 1934-1943 complètent ces renseignements et paraissent au tableau 1 du présent rapport. La statistique de conversion est donnée à la page 30 du présent rapport.

Ce rapport contient un résumé historique, des stocks de tabac non manufacturé, quantité prise des stocks, total des exportations, quantité et valeur des exportations et importations totales du tabac en feuilles, brut. Cette série est, dans la plupart des cas, continue de 1938 à 1951.
