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PRELIMINARY ESTIMATE OF THE PRINCIPAL STATISTICS OF THE BREAD AND OTHER BAKERY PRODUCTS INDUSTRY

## 1949

To meet the demand for early statistics on the production of the Bread and Other Bakery Products Industry the Dominion Bureau of Statistics has prepared a preliminary compilation based on the retums received by May fifteenth, 1950, from 342 establishments having a production of $\$ 50,000$ and over. The estimate is based on the compilation of identical firms for both 1948 and 1949 in order to arrive at the percentage changes for 1949. Figures from Newfoundland are not included in this estimate.

In making this estimate one difficulty was encountered, in as much as a few large firms did not send in their returns by the date set. These were not included in the compilation. Another factor which might be a source of error is that in making the estimate it was assumed that the rate of increase for the small firms left out was the same as for the firms with a production of $\$ 50,000$ or over. In view of the fact that these smaller firms produce less than 26 per cent of the total value of production, the margin of error, is therefore, substantially reduced.

Table 1 below shows the principal statistics for the year 1948, and the proluminary estimate for 1949. Table II shows a preliminary estimate of the consumption of flour used in the industry in 1949.
