MANUFACTURES OF THE NON-METALLIC MINERALS

THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1933.

Production from the aerated waters industry in Canada was valued at \$10,465,745 in 1933. This output was 5 per cent under the value of \$11,067,886 for 1932 and 23 per cent under the record of \$13,550,407 reported for 1930.

In 1933 there were 374 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making non-alcoholic carbonated beverages. Of these, 145 were in Ontario, 113 in Quebec, 26 in Nova Scotia, 23 in British Columbia, 21 in New Brunswick, 15 in Saskatchewan, 14 in Alberta, 14 in Manitoba, and 3 in Prince Edward Island. Works in Quebec and Ontario accounted for 81.5 per cent of the total production and 75 per cent of the employees.

Capital employed in the industry was reported at \$12,856,731 including \$8,037,485 as the value of lands, buildings and equipment, \$1,569,642 as the value of materials on hand and in process, \$362,430 as the value of finished products on hand, and \$2,887,174 as operating capital.

Employees numbered 2,321 including 673 on salaries and 1,648 on wages. Salaries amounted to \$912,574 and wages to \$1,485,288.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$9,376,691 at the works, syrups and fruit juices at \$928,106, natural mineral waters at \$77,125, and miscellaneous products at \$83,823.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$519,326 by concerns in the Brewing Industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages amounted to \$9,896,017 including \$4,254,081 for Quebec, \$3,608,827 for Ontario, \$672,993 for Manitoba, \$393,794 for Alberta, \$272,392 for New Brunswick, \$271,204 for British Columbia, \$201,860 for Saskatchewan, \$201,834 for Nova Scotia and \$19,032 for Prince Edward Island.

Imports into Canada of mineral and aerated waters were valued at \$77,552 during 1933 and exports for the same period amounted to \$5,572.
