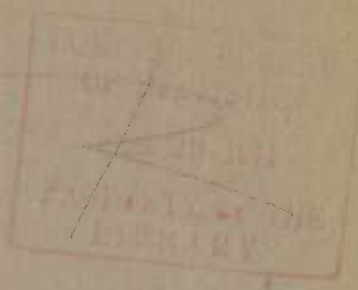

THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1939

Manufactures of carbonated beverages in Canada reported a gain of over 10 per cent in the value of products in 1939 as compared with 1938. Output from these factories in 1939 was worth \$28,743,811 at factory selling prices compared with \$26,094,126 in 1938.

In 1939 there were 447 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making non-alcoholic carbonated beverages. Of these, 163 were in Ontario, 142 in Quebec, 30 in Nova Scotia, 26 in British Columbia, 15 in New Brunswick, 21 in Saskatchewan, 25 in Manitoba, 19 in Alberta, and 6 in Prince Edward Island. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for 80 per cent of the total production and 76 per cent of the employees. In addition, 10 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 2 in British Columbia.

Capital employed in the industry was reported at \$20,132,465 including \$12,375,154 as the value of lands, buildings and equipment, \$3,906,333 as the value of materials, stocks in process and finished products on hand, and \$3,850,978 as operating capital.

Employees numbered 4,915 including 1,365 on salaries and 3,550 on wages. Salaries amounted to \$1,973,932 and wages to \$3,554,268.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$25,606,519 at the works, syrups and concentrates at \$2,955,057, natural mineral waters at \$95,531 and miscellaneous products at \$86,704.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$655,979 by firms in the Brewing Industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages amounted to \$26,262,498.

Imports into Canada of mineral and aerated waters were valued at \$69,850 during 1939 and exports for the same period amounted to \$1,842.

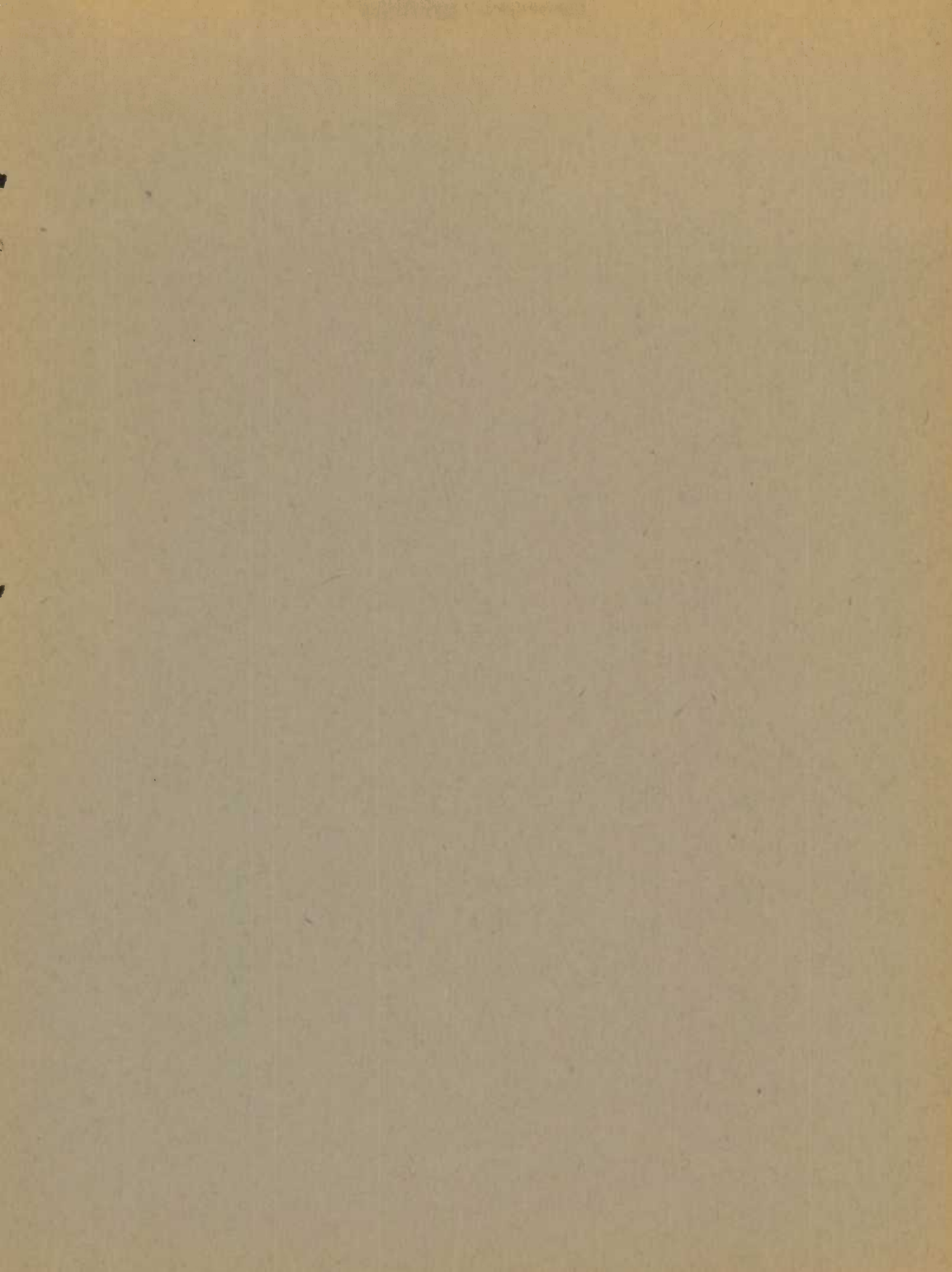
